Dear Mr. Cullen:

This letter is to notify you that Adobe Associates, Inc. (AAI) will no longer be providing the civil engineering services for the planned BIA Road 93 cut slope near Highway 128, the upslope disposal fill, as well as Phase 2 of the landslide repair west of the former guard shack location at Dry Creek Rancheria, 3250 Highway 128. We had prepared plans and even made a recent resubmittal on said GRD14-017 permit. Brunsing Associates, Inc. prepared a geotechnical investigation at the two sites; the results were presented in reports dated December 19, 2013 and July 17, 2013.

#### **Replacement Civil Engineer**

We understand that Dry Creek Rancheria will be moving forward with an in house engineer for the site grading and construction inspections for this project. Since AAI will no longer be the Civil Engineer of Record, the replacement civil engineer should now become the engineer of record and AAI would then be removed. The replacement civil engineer should state in writing that they are willing to accept responsibility for the project.
