




#### Rental Agreement

The RRRA purposes that the following the control of the 10th 20-10th 20-1 for "Day Use" only. The RRRA purposes that the following represent the terms and conditions governing said lease:

- Agrees to pay a daily rental fee of \$250.00. A portion of the rental fee may be waived at the sole discretion of the RRRA. Any waiver will apply only to the specific reatal period designated at the time the agreement is signed.

- 7. Will be required to show a certificate of insurance two weeks prior to the event, in full force and effect, at the time the rental agreement is executed. The amount of the insurance will be determined in advance by the RRRA but shall not exceed \$1,000,000.
- 8 Agrees to hold harmless the RRRA in case of any accident or other occurrence, which results in damage to personal or real property.
- 9. Agrees to hold harmless the RRRA in case of an accident or other occurrence, which causes bodily injury to any person or person.
- 10. Is solely responsible for obtaining any and all permits required by the County of Sonoma, State of Catifornia
- 11. Will be allowed to post signs the day of the event. All signs must be removed from the property by dusk on the day of the rental.
