I briefly spoke with TJ and he let me know that the building permit adds a second story for the proposed office space, and the new manufacturing & cleanroom is similar sewer output to the existing manufacturing.

Can you provide me more information about the existing, and previous output of the manufacturing & cleanroom space? I noticed that the WWDS has 4750 GPD. The office will generate 320 GPD, per Exhibit A [(6000 SF office) (0.19 ESD/1000 SF office) (280 GPD/ESD) = 319.2 GPD)]. So, it looks like there is about 4,430 GPD for manufacturing & cleanroom. Does this sounds reasonable? Is there a way to determine TSS and BOD? If the manufacturing process has not changed much from existing, then it is kind of a mute point...


