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

Re: Well Abandonment on Yuba Drive

To whom it may concern:

We are working for California Water Service Company and planning on abandoning the well inside the building located between addresses 1252 & 1300 Yuba Dr. There are multiple wells on this location. The one we are to abandon is inside a building without a removable roof over it so we cannot set up a pulling rig to try to remove, rip or perforate the casing. We cannot blast perforate since one of the other wells is also inside this building literally 5ft away from the well we need to abandon. They cannot turn any of the wells off during our process so blasting or cementing the entire well will be impossible as this would allow cement to migrate over to the running wells, contaminating those wells and the community water lines.

We would like to fill the well up with clean, washed 3/8" pea gravel to 50' below grade and then pour the cement mixture from 50' to surface. We cannot dig the casing down below grade as the well is flush with the concrete pad inside the building and doing so would compromise the buildings foundation. We will pour the cement to the surface and smooth it over on top of casing which is flush with the existing concrete slab.

Please let us know if you have any other questions or if we have your approval to move forward with this plan.
