I understand from the City of Santa Rosa's consultants, Harland Bartholomew and Associates and Parsons Engineering Science, that a monitoring well is proposed to be installed on the subject property referenced above, as part of a baseline water quality study in support of the Environmental Impact Report for the proposed Santa Rosa Long-term Wastewater Project.

As land owner or land owner's representative of the subject property, I the undersigned grant permission to personnel from the HBA/Parsons Engineering Science team and their well drilling and land surveyor subcontractors to enter the site for the purpose of conducting well construction and well sampling activities.

In addition, I also grant permission to a county inspector from the Permit and Resource Management Department to visit the property both before the work begins, to verify the consultant's representation of the relation of the proposed well site to existing site conditions (i.e., location of the well with respect to property lines, roads, and nearby septic tanks or leach fields), and to witness the emplacement of the well's sanitary seal.

Dear Philip,

My apologies for the delay in reviewing your additional documentation. In 1995, eighteen monitoring wells were drilled in Sonoma county as part of a Santa Rosa City hydrology study. Now that the study is complete, you have asked the potential for the status of these wells to be upgraded from monitoring well to domestic drinking water well. After a review of the applications and well construction reports, and discussions with the well driller, the following wells are noted to meet the standards for a domestic well. Further detail about these wells may be found in your letter to me of November 9, 1998.

With the recent receipt of your check for \$584 (3/19/99 #0369787) all permits and fees for all of the eighteen wells are current with this department.

The remaining wells were either dry holes, were unwanted by the property owner, or did not meet domestic well standards. These wells were destroyed at the time of drilling or currently have destruct permits on file.
